### Covid-19 Health & safety Instructions for Events

**These instructions will apply to any events sanctioned by MSUK after 4-7-2020 until further notice**

**General:** These rules apply to all club members and any invited club members.

- Competitors and officials only allowed on site (NO spectators, whether they be family, friends or bystanders)
- NO on site paperwork - pre book and prepay only.
- Nobody showing symptoms of CV19 or who has been in contact with anybody who has CV19 in the previous 14 days to attend the event.
- If anyone is officiating and entering the event BOTH forms mentioned below must be submitted.
- Everyone is recommended to read the MSUK website, "Getting Motorsport Back on Track"

#### **Officials:**

- Marshalls and officials MUST submit an Officials signing on sheet along with a COVID free declaration BEFORE the event
- They will also have to supply their own tabards and any necessary PPE. Worn PPE is optional as long as social distancing is observed.
- Two Covid Officials (one for RTV, one for CCV) will be appointed whose responsibility will be to remind people of social distancing and other precautions as necessary.
- Social distancing will be observed at all times at the meeting. Hand cleaner/disinfectant is recommended and will be supplied by the individual.
- No score cards will be used; the master sheet is the only one which will be used. Score accuracy is the responsibility of the competitor.

#### **Drivers:**

- Entry forms used must be the new ones issued by MSUK, these will be emailed to competitors pre meeting, and must be filled in, signed and emailed back to SOM. [sueflanders@btinternet.com](mailto:sueflanders@btinternet.com)
- Payment by bank transfer only prior to the meeting. **Sort code 40-34-29 Account No. 01371789 £30 per entry**
- Alternative arrangements will be made for people without email or bank facilities.
- The requirement for an MSUK license still stands.
- No double driven vehicles except where the drivers are both from the same household.
- No passengers except where the driver and passenger are both from the same household.

#### **Vehicles:**

- There will be NO scrutineering at the event. The new MSUK forms will include a declaration that the vehicle is up to scrutineering standards, so a visual inspection should be sufficient at the event. The club reserves the right to inspect any vehicle that it deems necessary.
- If drivers are in doubt as to vehicle eligibility, suitability and safety – ASK.

#### **Equipment for the event and course layout:**

- ALL equipment used to layout MUST be sterilised before and during the event as required.
- Marshalls ONLY to carry out course repairs.
